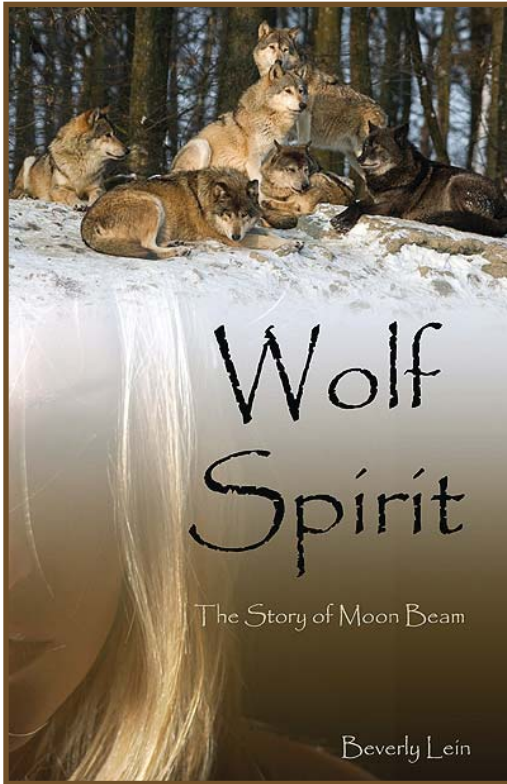

Canadian author **Beverly Lein** vividly paints a portrait of 1840s life in her newest novel, **Wolf Spirit: The Story of Moon Beam**. This coming-of-age story mixes adventure with a greater story of survival, love, and self-reliance.

Set in Northern Canada, this fictional adventure follows the life of Rachel (Moon Beam) an orphaned settler and her adopted wolf pack as she struggles to survive the perils of the untamed wilderness.

After Rachel saves Storm, an Indian Chief from a rogue grizzly attack, the two young people are thrown together in a clash of two cultures, but united in their feelings for each other. **Wolf Spirit: The Story of Moon Beam** is an accessible book for all ages, and fosters the current need in society to understand different cultures, and to learn to accept those that we share the land with in our country.

Compelling and lovingly written, this book will appeal to readers age 9-12 who want to step back in time and enjoy a family friendly adventure.
