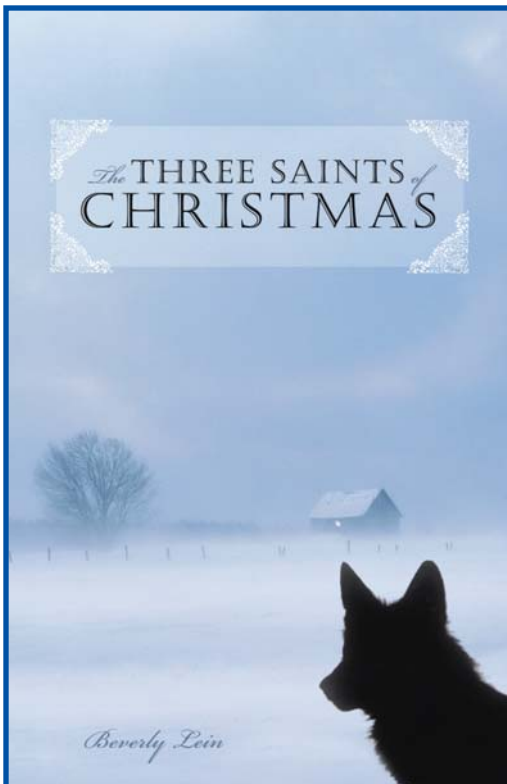


The THREE SAINTS *of* CHRISTMAS
